Abdulrasoul Salman is the director of the Kuwaiti Arts

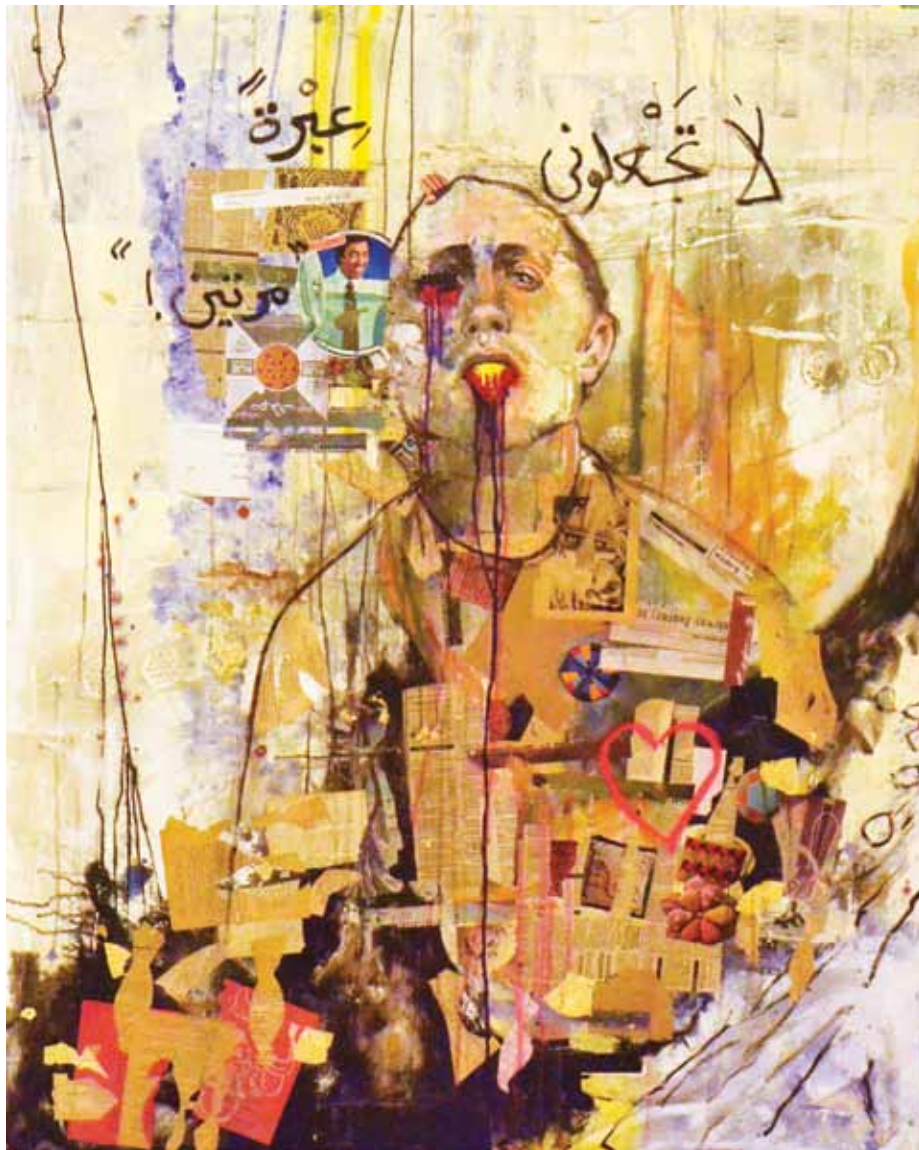
Association, proving that his passion for the arts stems beyond his personal practice. His paintings uncover human traces of culture and identity through their calm hues and stillness.
